



## Brick Lane School: Home–School Agreement

- ✓ A teaching pedagogy that matches pupils' communication and learning needs

### OUR WELLBEING APPROACH

**We promote wellbeing by supporting pupils to:**

- ✓ Build resilience and use coping strategies
- ✓ Take part in activities that grow confidence and self-esteem
- ✓ Encouraging positive relationships
- ✓ Building trust and emotional regulation
- ✓ Creating predictable and supportive environments to enable independence
- ✓ Staff training to support trauma informed practice

### WHAT THE SCHOOL WILL DO

**We will:**

- ✓ Provide a connected, inclusive curriculum that supports your child's development
- ✓ The school will tailor teaching approaches to meet individual pupil needs, taking into account their stage of communication development and cognitive profile
- ✓ Use a neurodivergent affirmative approach to behaviour, which is positive and non-

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- ✓ Foster an environment in which pupils feel confident, supported by safe spaces and trusted adults.
- ✓ Promote social, moral, spiritual, and cultural development
- ✓ Keep you informed about progress, behaviour, and attendance
- ✓ Treat all families with respect and work towards shared goals and vision

### You will also receive:

- ✓ Access to Class Dojo and iSAMS Parent Portal
- ✓ Regular and transparent communication
- ✓ Positive praise and updates on your child’s achievements
- ✓ Invitations to parent workshops, chat and chills, coffee mornings and special events
- ✓ An invitation to attend, in person, one Annual Review per year and two Pupil Progress Meetings.
- ✓ End of Year reports and Therapeutic Care Plan
- ✓ Incident reports (available upon request)

## WHAT WE ASK FROM FAMILIES

### Please support us by:

- Request meetings with relevant staff in advance to ensure discussions happen privately and appropriately
- Supporting our Neurodivergent Affirmative Behaviour policy and working collaboratively with behaviour and strategies
- Ensuring regular attendance and punctuality, following the Attendance Policy
- Attending Annual Reviews and consultations, and completing parent feedback
- Informing us of any home life changes that may affect your child
- Informing us of any external agencies involved that may affect provision
- Informing us of any medical needs, or changes
- Not sending medication without completion of forms and agreement
- Keeping emergency contact details up to date (three contacts minimum)
- Following the Complaints Procedure Policy if concerns arise
- Reading and returning all required forms promptly
- Collecting your child promptly if they are unwell or injured
- Communicating directly with transport companies if there are issues
- Monitoring age-appropriate media use at home, and identifying if support is required
- Treating all staff and community members with courtesy and respect
- Refrain from discussing pupils in front of them to protect their dignity, privacy, and emotional wellbeing.
